Policy Victories:

On March 1, the Safe Passing Law went into effect, requiring drivers to use "due caution" whenever they see people on the road. The law states that when a pedestrian is in the road drivers must not pass, nor speed, and must move over a lane if there's one to move into. On a single-lane road, drivers must allow at least a four-foot safety zone when they pass. Alternatively, drivers must slow to 25 mph and be prepared to stop until they can pass safely without endangering those sharing the road. Tri-State Transportation Campaign and partners led this policy victory. Read more here.

- ACLU-NJ released its annual 2021 report, A Vision of Justice, highlighting the organization's accomplishments, while centering the experiences and stories of partners and community members who have faced various inequities and been disenfranchised. Read more <u>here.</u>
- The Future is Electric, a new report commissioned by New Jersey Conservation Foundation in partnership with Acadia Center confirms that electrifying the building sector is beneficial to all, making buildings healthier and safer while reducing greenhouse gas emissions. The report finds that transitioning away from fossil fuels to electric is key to significantly reduce emissions from buildings, the second-largest source of greenhouse gas emissions in the state. - New Jersey Policy Perspective released a report *Breaking Down Murphy's FY 2023 Budget Proposal*. The report analyzes the different spending priorities by category and explains the impact that the \$48.9 billion budget would have on the lives of New Jersey residents. Read more <u>here.</u>
- The Gap: A Shortage of Affordable Homes, a new report released by the National Low Income Housing Coalition (NLIHC) and the Housing and Community Development Network of New Jersey (the Network), finds a national shortage of nearly seven million affordable and available rental homes for extremely low-income (ELI) renter



households. According to *The Gap*, in NJ, only 31 affordable and available rental homes exist for every 100 extremely low-income renter households. The report shows how these lowest-income renters were uniquely positioned to suffer disproportionately from lost income and housing insecurity during the pandemic. Read more <u>here</u>.
