Grantee News

- The American Civil Liberties Union of New Jersey (ACLU-NJ) and Salvation and Social Justice (SSJ) issued statements condemning the actions of the Trenton Police Department following the release of a U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) report documenting systemic, ongoing misconduct and excessive use of force in our state's capital. Both ACLU-NJ and SSJ commended the DOJ for the investigation and report findings, while acknowledging that the report is the first step in a process that will require additional action and community participation to ensure the safety and well-being of Trenton residents.
- Through a Freedom of Information Act lawsuit, ACLU-NJ obtained records indicating a planned expansion of immigrant detention centers across New Jersey by Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE). The proposed expansion could increase capacity by 600 beds in centers operating in Elizabeth and Trenton. Read more here and here.
