- The NJ For Transit coalition launched on May 14th to oppose proposed NJ Transit fare hikes and service cuts and advocated for long-term investment in affordable, efficient, and high-quality public transportation in NJ. Coalition members include NJ Policy Perspective, Environment NJ, Tri-State Transportation Campaign, the Anti-Poverty Network of NJ, NJ Citizen Action, Ironbound Community Corporation, and NJ Working Families Alliance. - Union County became the first NJ county to pass a resolution in support of legislation that would allow undocumented immigrants to obtain drivers' licenses on May 28th due to efforts by Faith in NJ, Wind of the Spirit, NJ Alliance for Immigrant Justice, and partners. - The Newark Municipal Council unanimously passed an ordinance establishing a municipal ID program on May 21st due to efforts by NJ Alliance for Immigrant Justice, American Friends Service Committee, Faith in NJ, Wind of the Spirit, ACLU-NJ, and Ironbound Community Corporation. The municipal ID pilot goes into effect on July 1st, with citywide implementation starting August 1st. For more information, read [here](#).
- Newark Mayor Ras Baraka signed an executive order establishing a Newark Civilian Complaint Review Board (CCRB) on April 30th due to advocacy by ACLU-NJ, Ironbound Community Corporation, the NJ Institute for Social Justice, and partners.
